Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about natural disasters through physical and locational knowledge. Children will learn all about volcanoes focusing on where they are, how they are formed and the structure inside. Children will complete a case study on Iceland and its volcanic eruption.

Computing
In computing, we will be learning about Data loggers. We will be using them to collect data and use the data we have collected to answer questions.

Science

In Science, our focus will be on states of matter and the water cycle! We will be grouping and comparing materials, observing the changes of state and identifying the parts played in evaporation and condensation.

Maths

Throughout the half term, we will be focusing further on fractions and time. We will also continue to focus on our times tables.

English

In English, we will base our learning on the story of 'When the Giant Stirred'. The story of one island, formed and ultimately destroyed by the action of a volcano. We will be working towards writing a story from the point of view of one of the characters in the text using a variety of descriptive sentences.

Music

In Music, we will be learning to appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality recorded music from composers and musicians. We will be creating simple melodies together and explore the following question: How does music teach us about our Community?
