



## Maths Pupil Voice Summer 2019

- Maths Pupil Voice has been very positive. The majority of the children voted 'Yes' for enjoying Maths and gave reasons such as:  
"We learn lots." "It's challenging and fun." "It's important, I like to do sums."  
"I like learning different methods to sort things out." "Once you are confident with the skill I find it enjoyable." "I like solving challenges."
- Children's views on Morning Maths were very positive, children said it gave them the opportunity to recap previously taught skills and also the opportunity to have mop up when they find things difficult.
- All classes with the exception of Year 1 do Maths every day. Year 1 have rotation mornings so complete Maths 3 or 4 times a week.
- Books are marked daily giving the children regular feedback.
- Most of the children in the year groups have stated that there is appropriate challenge and the work set is ok for them. On the sheets there were some children who stated it was very easy - VF didn't find this when completing the book scrutiny.
- For the question on how to improve Maths further the following responses were stated:
  - All year groups have stated that they would like to go outside more for Maths.
  - Do more Maths within other lessons.
  - Add more levels of challenge within the lessons.
- All year groups have stated that they have access to resources and can use them within lessons.
- When asked what areas they find difficult most classes stated they find Fractions, time and reasoning the most difficult.

### Next steps:

- Continue Morning Maths to ensure children have the opportunity to consolidate and practice their mathematical learning.
- Year 1 to complete Maths on a daily occurrence.
- Continue to complete book scrutiny's to check the level of challenge is appropriate for all.
- Plan an active/outdoor Maths week - all classes to complete as series of Maths lessons outside/outside the classroom.
- Make Fractions, Time and reasoning a continued priority on the Maths action plan.
