

Geography Pupil Voice 2019-2020

- Most children said they enjoyed geography. "I love learning about all the world" Year 1.
- Most children said they were taught geography weekly.
- Children had a good recall of what they had been taught in geography which correlated with the long-term plans. They were more vocal about the units they were particularly interested in.
- Children reported that they did work outside for geography but not often. "We did dataloggers outside." Year 3. "We went into Chester." Year 6.
- All children said their books were marked. "We get RARs sometimes." Year 2 "I like getting stickers." Year 1
- Most children found the work challenging. "Thinking about cause and effect and making links is hard." Year 6.
- Children said they used maps, atlases, data loggers as well as resources like google earth on the internet.
- Children came up with a variety of ways to improve geography: Go outside more, learn about more places, more practical work, more school trips. Some said less writing and a greater variety of activities. Year 5 wanted to be involved with the planning!

Next Steps:

- Ensure the new geography curriculum is varied and continues to be challenging.
- Ensure all teachers take advantage of opportunities to work outside the classroom.
