

Geography

In Geography, the children will have the opportunity to explore world maps and atlases. They will be identifying UK countries and capitals and comparing British homes to homes from around the world. Within this, the children will have opportunity to study homes in the local area.

English

In English, we will be using a fiction book called 'Troll Swap' as the stimulus for our Reading and Writing. The children will be writing a story focusing on characters.

Design Technology

In DT, the children will be making Moving Pictures of animals in their homes. They will plan, make and evaluate their moving picture.

Computing

In Computing we are using E-ware Safety to learn how to be safe on the Internet.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be reading 'Bob the Street Cat' and discussing what makes a home. The children will also be reading 'The Great Big Book of Families' as part of our No Outsiders theme.

Vocabulary

Habitat, suitable, animals, humans, living, non-living, worldwide, adapted, sequence, character traits.

Home from Home

Science

In Science we are learning about Living Things and their Habitats. We will be exploring and comparing things that are living and non-living. Within our Forest School lessons, we will be looking at different habitats and discussing what makes a 'suitable' habitat for different insects and animals.

Art

In Art, we will be using our rolling and modelling skills to create a sculpture.

End Point

The children will have an understanding of a variety of homes for both animals and humans. They will construct homes in Forest School and build a model of a home from around the world.

PE

In PE, the children will be developing skills in throwing and catching. They will also have the opportunity to develop movements and sequences to create dances.

Music

As part of our music learning, the children will be exploring some South African music and linking ideas about pulse, rhythm and pitch. They will have opportunity to both sing and play instruments to accompany the music they hear.

Maths

In Maths, the children will be building on their maths knowledge, focusing on Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Money and early stages of Multiplication. The children will also develop their problem solving and reasoning skills.
