Year One



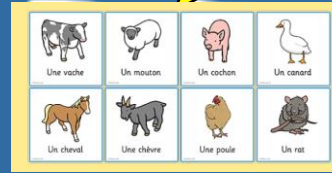
Children engage in simple greetings, days of the week and numbers to 10 (through playground games) and some colours.



Year Two



Children will learn additional colours, animals and weather phrases.



Children will learn about different body parts and commands.



The children will be asked to describe body parts and facial features. They will describe animals and different types of weather

They children will go on a picnic and describe different foods. They will be introduced to fruits and vegetables

In Year 3 the children will recap greetings, feelings, numbers (1-15), animals and colours. They will look at festivals including Christmas and Easter.

Year Three



The children will look at days of the week and months of the year.

In Year 4 the children will recap Year 3 core language. The children will look at family members and family trees.

The children will look at 'My town, Your town' specifically directions. The children will continue to work on basic phrases.



Year Four



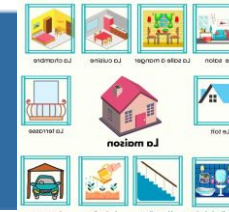
In Year 6, the children will recap Year 5 learning, they will learn how to describe their house, look at playing and enjoying sport. The children will look at café culture, funfairs and their favourite things. They will continue to work on basic phrases.

Children will learn numbers to 100 and look at transition to KS3 French lessons.
